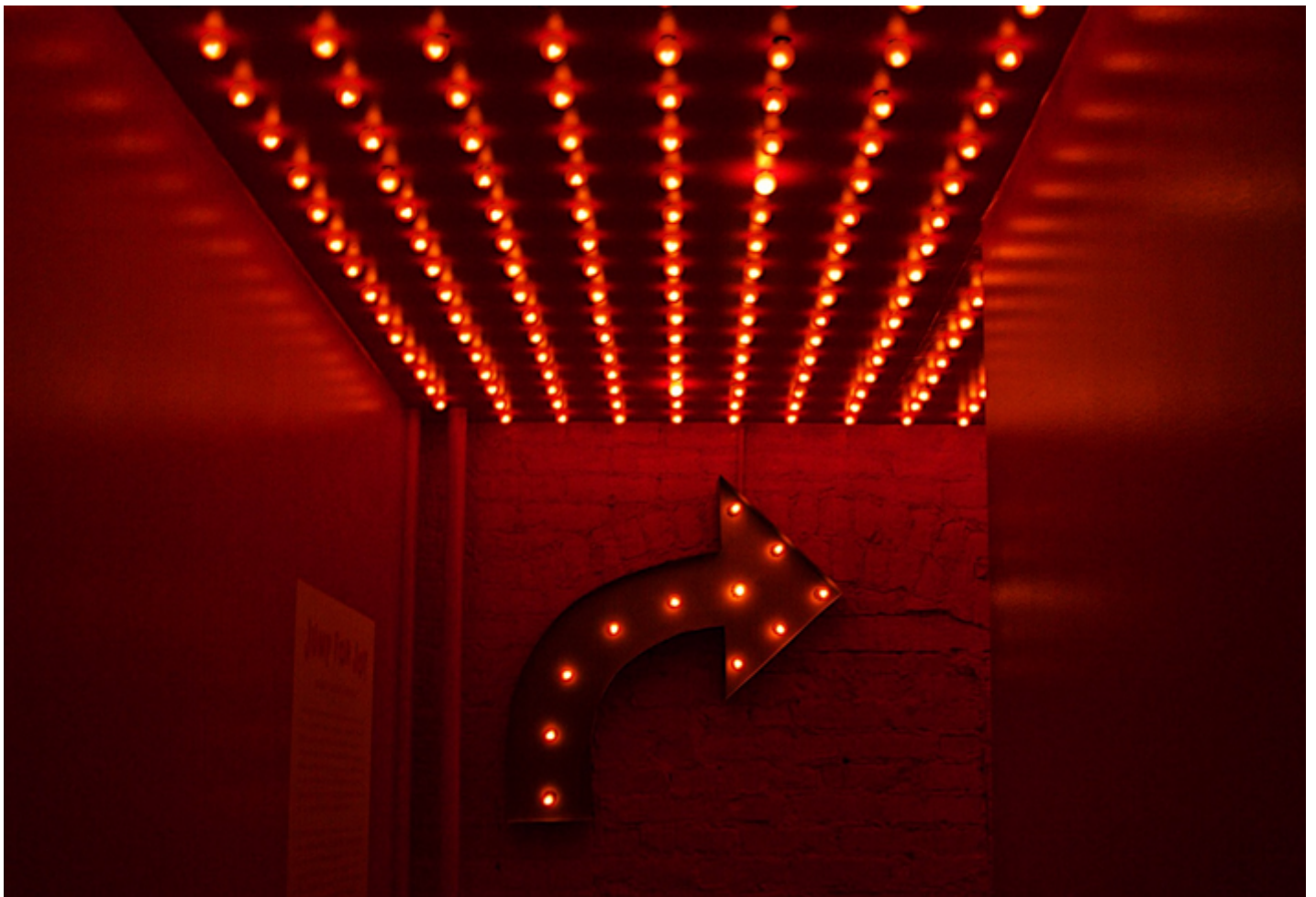


A Secret Late-Night Jazz Bar Is Opening In The CBD!
